








PSW signed MoU with SDPI

Knowledge Sharing and ICT



For organizations to flourish, it is important that its people are empowered, & one big way of accomplishing that is to create & institutionalize a culture of knowledge sharing & to instill in its people a sense of ownership in the core values of the organization. This becomes all the more significant in organizations like Customs where application of specialized knowledge & experience is required. Pakistan Single Window Company, a public sector company established by Pakistan Customs, is not only digitalizing cross border trade related processes in Pakistan, but it is also using technology for building a culture of knowledge sharing amongst its own people, and amongst those of OGAs & other stakeholders of cross border trade. It is a knowledge portal where entire cross-border trade related regulatory information of all commodities has been

evidence of this fact is PSW's TRADEVERSE, the Trade Information Portal of Pakistan, which was successfully

made available. The laws, regulations and procedural requirements pertaining to different government departments involved in cross border trade are now easily assessable through PSW's TRADEVERSE. It also contains useful statistical data related to international trade. Since its launch, TRADEVERSE has been serving trade related information not only to the trade community of Pakistan, but also to interested parties across the globe. The Phase-I of Pakistan Single Window System was successfully rolled-out on 30 June 2022 by integrating the cross-border trade related processes of 06 Other Government Agencies (OGAs) namely Department of Plant Protection (DPP), Animal Quarantine Department (AQD), Pakistan Standard & Quality Control Authority (PSQCA), Federal Seed Certification & Research Department (FSCRD), Export Development Fund (EDF) and Pakistan Customs. PSW's integrated electronic platform enables the stakeholders of the aforementioned OGAs to benefit from the centralized system that will help in fulfilling all import, export, and transit related regulatory requirements.

Before and after deploying any module or functionality in PSW, it is made sure that Change Management activities with all stakeholders including staff of government departments, traders, trade associations etc. have been conducted vigorously. These include seminars, training sessions, system demos, workshops etc which are mostly recorded hence making them available to the relevant people for further knowledge sharing. User manuals, video-audio guides and podcasts are regularly made available for the public on PSW's website (www.psw.gov.pk). In this manner, PSW has contributed to transforming the culture of several government departments from being less accessible to becoming more accessible, transparent and knowledge-driven! Embracing ICT solutions for developing a data base of knowledge and providing access of this knowledge pool to relevant stakeholders can assist organizations in achieving the objective of empowering its people, especially the future generations.
