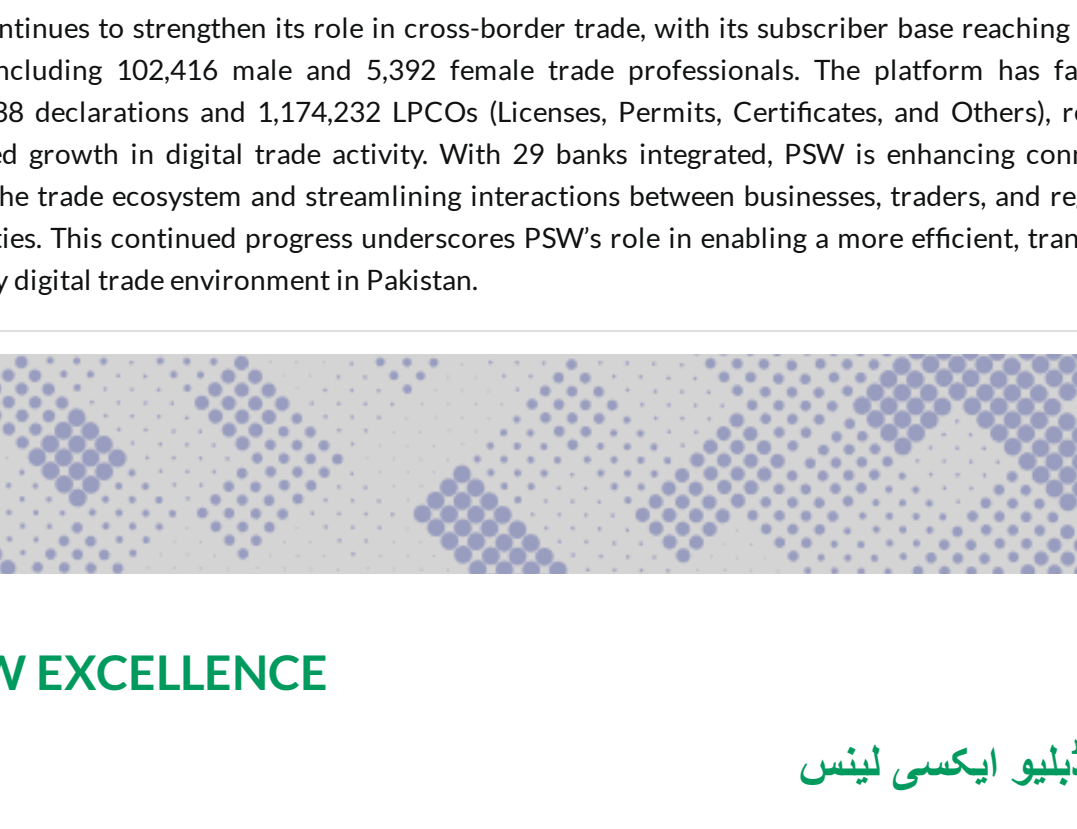

PSW continues to strengthen its role in cross-border trade, with its subscriber base reaching 108,059 users, including 102,416 male and 5,392 female trade professionals. The platform has facilitated 1,699,238 declarations and 1,174,232 LPOs (Licenses, Permits, Certificates, and Others), reflecting sustained growth in digital trade activity. With 29 banks integrated, PSW is enhancing connectivity across the trade ecosystem and streamlining interactions between businesses, traders, and regulatory authorities. This continued progress underscores PSW's role in enabling a more efficient, transparent, and fully digital trade environment in Pakistan.

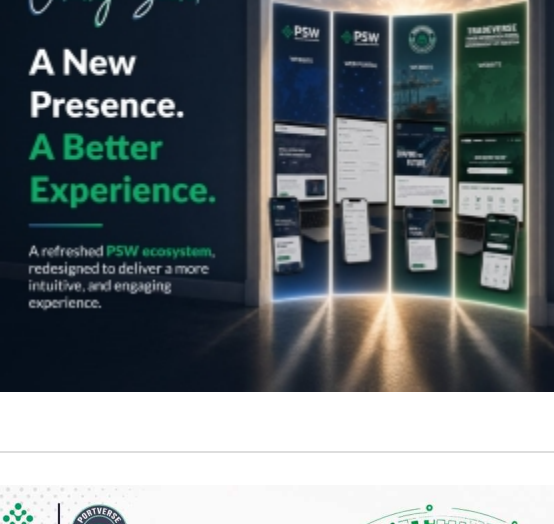

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PortVerse Enables End-to-End Digital Processing of Delivery Orders for an entire RORO Vessel

PortVerse has achieved another significant milestone by enabling the complete digital processing of all Delivery Orders (DOs) for an entire Roll-on/Roll-off (RORO) vessel carrying commercial vehicles. This marks the first time all DOs for a RORO vessel are being processed through the platform, expanding PortVerse's digital capabilities across another key cargo segment.

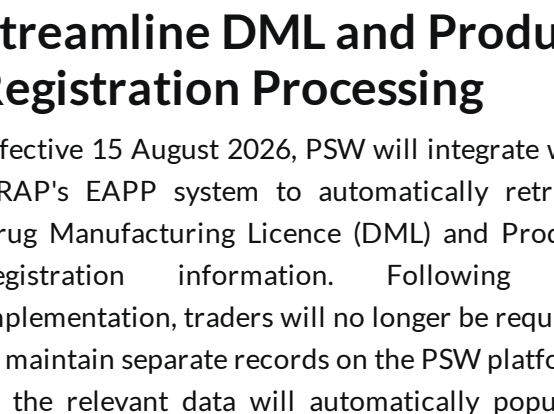
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PSW to Introduce Revised Payment Mechanism for Karachi Collectorate Goods Declarations

Effective 3 August 2026, the payment mechanism for Goods Declarations (GDs) related to Karachi Collectorates will transition to LUMS's "Bill - Invoice" option. Under the revised process, all duties, taxes, and applicable fees will be paid through the Bill - Invoice service instead of the FBR biller.

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DRAP EAPP Integration to Streamline DML and Product Registration Processing

Effective 15 August 2026, PSW will integrate with DRAP's EAPP system to automatically retrieve Drug Manufacturing Licence (DML) and Product Registration information. Following the implementation, traders will no longer be required to maintain separate records on the PSW platform, as the relevant data will automatically populate applicable workflows.

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PSW Convenes Inaugural Khadijah Advisory Board to Expand Market Access for Women Exporters

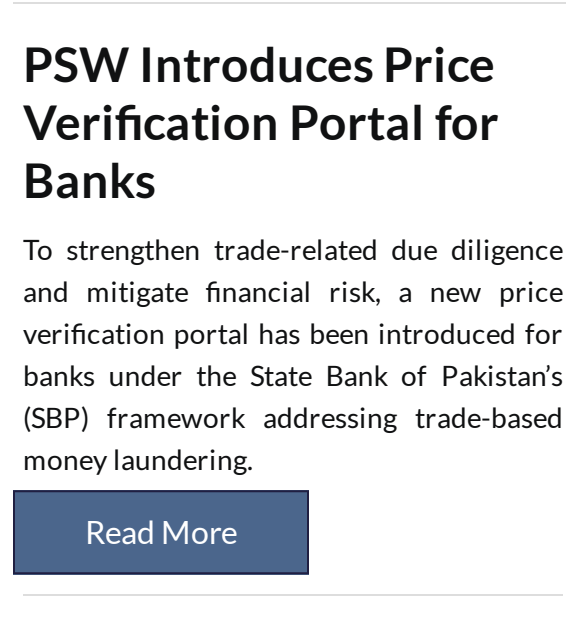

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PSW Introduces Price Verification Portal for Banks

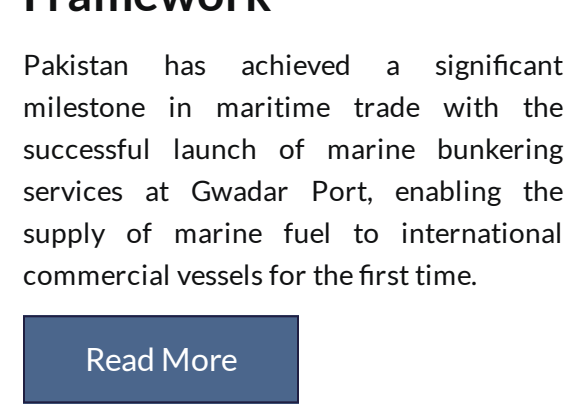
To strengthen trade-related due diligence and mitigate financial risk, a new price verification portal has been introduced for banks under the State Bank of Pakistan's (SBP) framework addressing trade-based money laundering.

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Government Extends Duty Drawback Scheme for Rice Exporters

The Federal Government has extended the concessional duty drawback scheme for rice exporters until 30 September 2026, while enhancing incentives to strengthen the global competitiveness of Pakistani rice. Under the revised scheme, eligible drawback claims will be generated through the PSW platform for shipments made during the extended period, or until the Rs20 billion allocation is fully utilized, whichever occurs first.

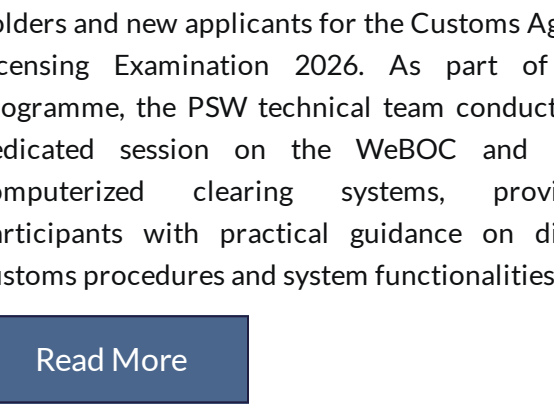
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Gwadar Port Launches First-Ever Marine Bunkering Service Under PSW's Digital Customs Framework

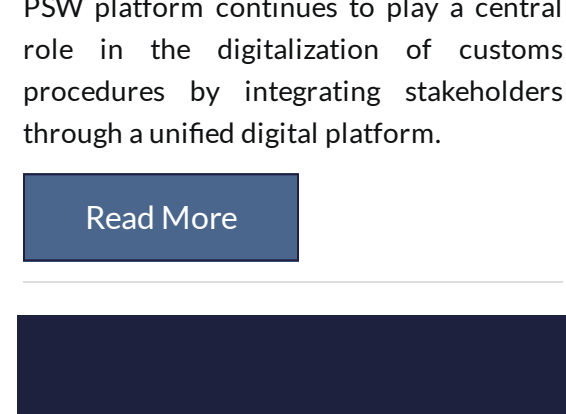
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PSW Supports KCAA Training for Customs Agents Licensing Examination

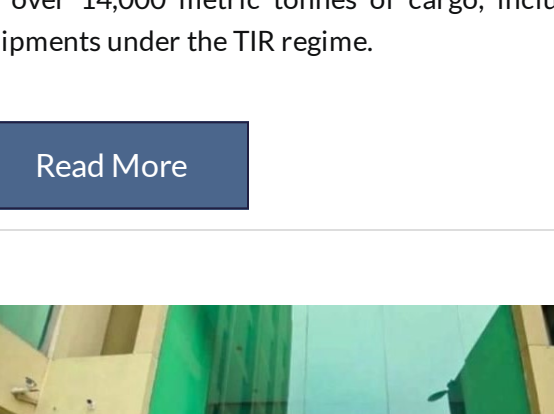
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Government Fast-Tracks Maritime Reforms to Boost Trade, Port Efficiency

Pakistan is advancing a wide-ranging maritime reform agenda to improve port performance, strengthen trade facilitation, and enhance the efficiency of customs operations. As part of these reforms, the PSW platform continues to play a central role in the digitalization of customs procedures by integrating stakeholders through a unified digital platform.

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PSW Supports Export Shipment via Pakistan's New Iran, China Trade Corridors

Pakistan has operationalized two new overland trade corridors through Iran and China, providing Central Asian countries with additional access to Pakistani ports and expanding regional trade connectivity. Since becoming operational in April 2026, the corridors have facilitated the movement of over 14,000 metric tonnes of cargo, including shipments under the TIR regime.

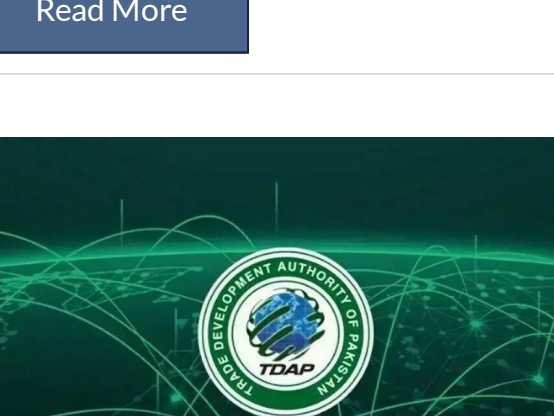
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Sindh Cabinet Approves Three-Year Service Level Agreement with PSW

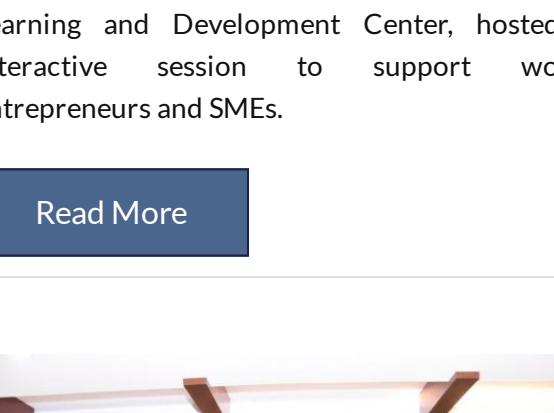
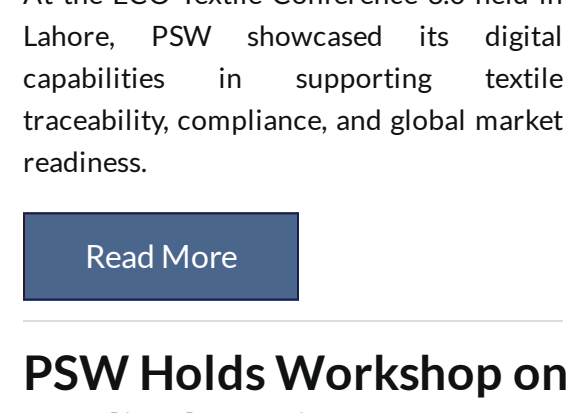
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Driving Inclusive Growth: PSW Supports Launch of FPCCI's "Home to Hub" Initiative to Empower Women Entrepreneurs

PSW conducted an interactive session at FPCCI on "Medical Devices for Commercial Imports and Integration with the DRAP System."

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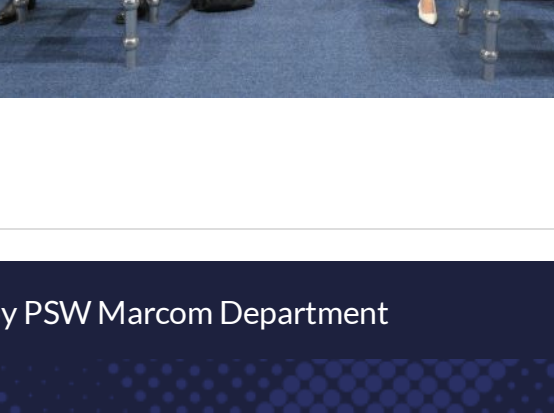

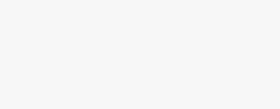
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PSW Promotes Inclusive Hiring Through Participation in Reverse Career Expo

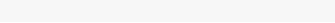
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
