PSW Expands Digital Trade Reach with 104K+ Registered Users Across Pakistan



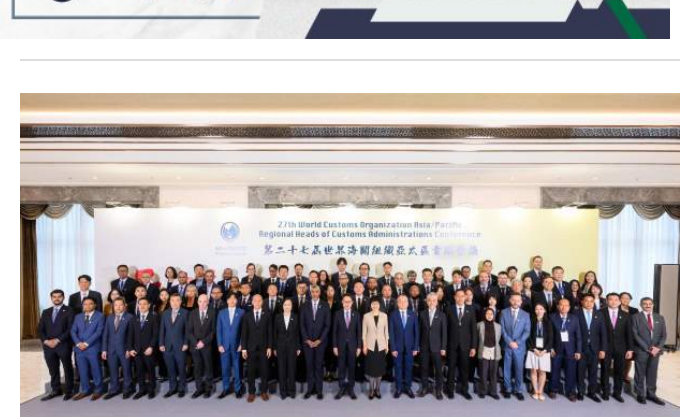

PSW and EXIM Bank Partner to Enable Data-Driven Trade Finance

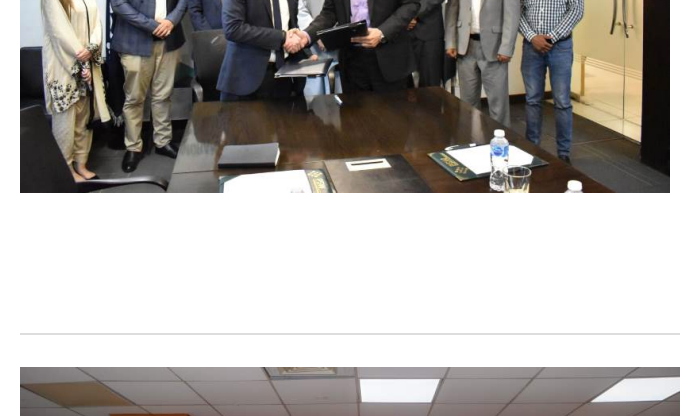
